<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Application forms should be presented at a monthly meeting of the club (held 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday every month at Thornton Hough Parish Church Hall at 8pm) and MUST be accompanied by the appropriate fee.</li> <li>New members must complete 4 rides with the club before submitting an application.</li> <li>An applicant who has been a member of another club must have a clearance note from that club with the application unless the club is defunct.</li> <li>Applicants over 16 should attend the monthly meeting when their application is presented, but will be asked to step outside while it is being considered. In exceptional circumstances the proposer and seconder together can represent the applicant. Otherwise the application shall not be considered.</li> <li>Upon election a member receives a club badge, which will remain the property of the club..</li> <li>Members should make arrangements for insurance if they require it. It is not provided by the club.</li> <li>Members over 18 are obliged to perform at least 2 marshalling duties as per the rota published each year.</li> <li>See separate sheet for key Club contact details and list of normal Club activities.</li> <li>A Renewal Form should be completed annually to re-join the club giving current contact details etc.</li> </ol>
